

## **Wild Rose Farm**

### **Position Opening, General Barn Help**

**POSITION OPEN:** 09/15/2025

**CLOSING DATE:** Open until filled

**POSITION DESCRIPTION:** Part-time general barn help for Fall 2024; 6-10 hours per week, M-W-F 7:30-10am preferred, although T-Th-Sa could also work. Additional hours may be available and some (limited) schedule flexibility possible. Must be (mostly) available through the winter holidays. Work commitment through June 2025 preferred.

**DUTIES:** Include general barn duties such as feeding, horse turnout, stall cleaning and general barn maintenance as well as routine tractor chores. Must be able to meet minimum physical requirements (see below).

**START DATE:** ASAP

**COMPENSATION:**

\$15.50 – \$25.00 per hour DOE and assigned duties. Increases dependent on job performance, dependability and additional work skills developed/demonstrated.

**EXPERIENCE REQUIRED:**

- Significant horse experience required.
- Experience in a combined training environment a plus, but not required.
- Tractor experience a plus.

**MINIMUM PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:**

Any work at Wild Rose Farm will require the following:

- Must be able to work at a moderate physical level for 2-3 hours including pushing wheelbarrows, picking stalls, spreading bedding, measuring out hay and grain meals.
- Must be able to repeatedly lead horses to and from paddocks.
- Occasional lifting of 50lb weights (grain sacks) and shifting of up to 125lbs (hay bales)
- Must be able to lift 20lb weights above the shoulders (stable blankets and turnout sheets)
